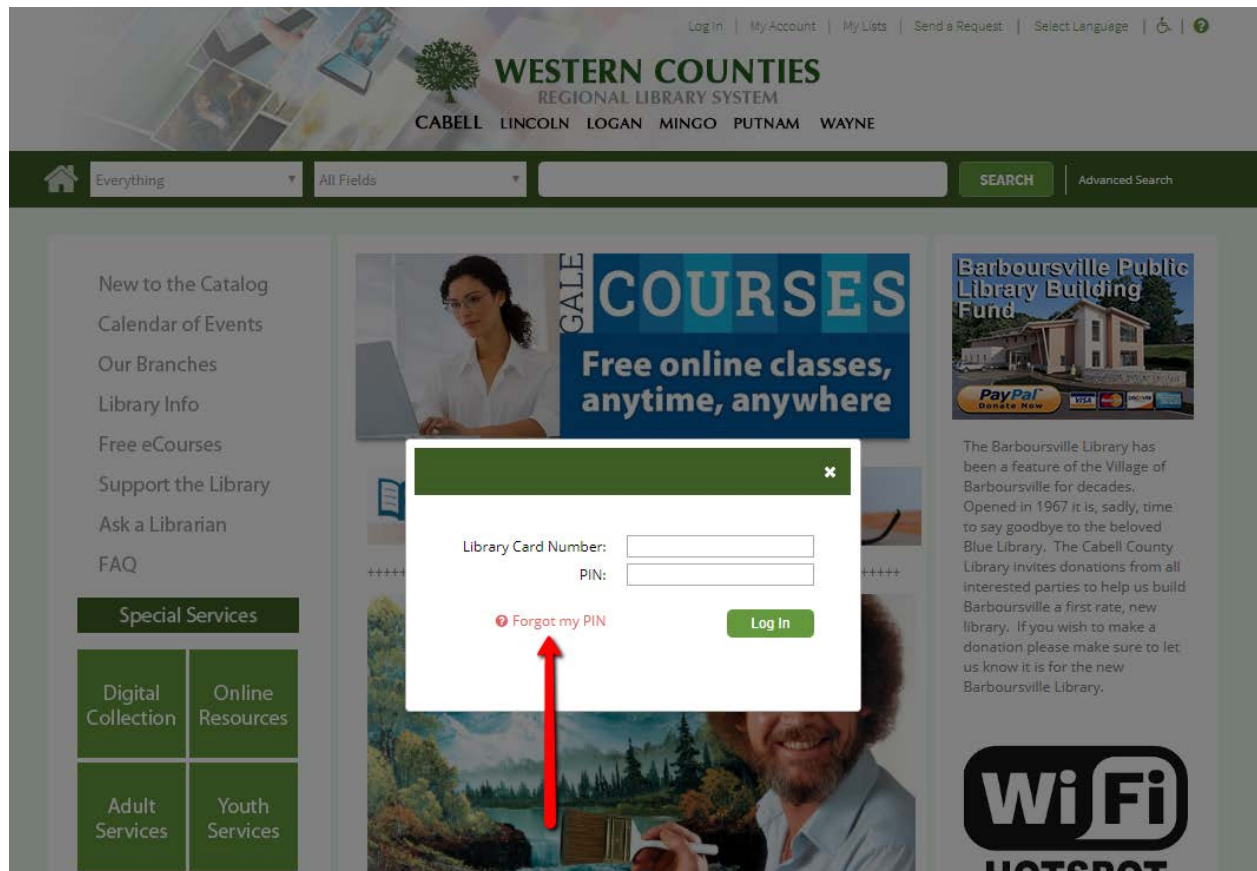



PIN (Personal Identification Number)

Anyone can search the catalog, but to place a hold, renew or view your library record, you will need your library card number (the 10/14 digit number located under the barcode on the back of your library card) and a PIN. You can obtain your PIN by visiting any of our libraries and upon presentation of identification we will give you your PIN. This is necessary to assure the confidentiality of our library patron records. If you forget or lose your PIN, you will need to come to the library with proper ID.

If you have an e-mail linked to your library account you may also request your PIN via our website by requesting to reset your pin number and providing your library card number.

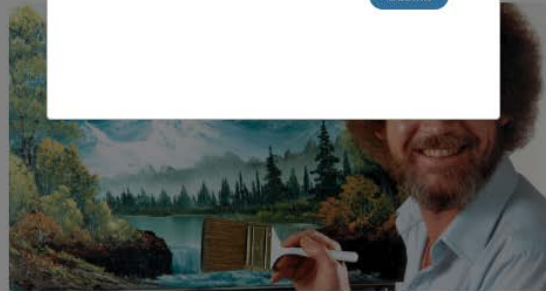
